Introduction

This policy outlines the standards which Christ Church Lille (hereafter referred to as CCL) requires all users of its electronic communications systems and equipment to follow.

What is covered by the Policy?

The use of the wi-fi network supplied by CCL.

Who is covered by the Policy?

This policy covers all individuals who wish to use the wi-fi network supplied by CCL.

Internet Use

- It is our church policy not to allow unsupervised internet access to under 18's. Should individuals or groups wish to use our wi-fi facilities, they must ensure under 18's follow this policy or access will be withdrawn.
- Users are reminded that their use of the Internet will be directly traceable to our Internet address.
- We ask you not to use the internet access for any activity that:

- Is illegal under current law
- Is defamatory, threatening, or intimidatory or which could be classed as bullying or harassment
- Involves obscene, profane or abusive language
- Contains pornographic material whether in writing, pictures, films, video clips or any other media
- Contains offensive material regarding sex, race, religion or any disability or sexual orientation
- Infringes third party rights or is otherwise unlawful or inappropriate
- Could be classified as internet abuse
- Involves illegal access or downloading of copyright material

Internet Content

CCL reserves the right to block access to any site. CCL will take reasonable steps to block any site it deems inappropriate, however, CCL cannot guarantee that all inappropriate content will be blocked. If you gain access to a site that you deem inappropriate close your web browser immediately.

Systems and Data Security

- CCL will provide internet access via the wireless network and will undertake reasonable steps to ensure it is secure

from unauthorised users. However, no guarantee can be made to this effect.

- You are responsible for your own anti-virus and malware precautions, CCL will not be held responsible for any damage to your equipment or data whilst connected to its network.
- You should not use a public network to access personal banking or other sensitive sites.
- You should not attempt to gain access to restricted areas of the CCL network or to any password protected information without being duly authorised to do so.

Monitoring and Compliance

CCL reserves the right to protect its network and systems by recording user activity but not content. That is to say that no content will be captured but that a list of activity may be recorded:

- To ensure that the use of the system is legitimate and in accordance with this policy
- To comply with any legal obligation
- If the use constitutes a criminal offence, the information will be handed to the police.

Specific Permissions

- Wireless access to the internet is granted to you in accordance with this policy.

- The password is subject to change without warning and will be circulated to authorised users.

Compliance

Use of the wifi network provided by Christ Church Lille infers your acceptance of this policy. Christ Church Lille reserves the right to remove access rights from individuals and will co-operate with any investigation over misuse of the internet with the relevant authorities.
