This morning I want you to imagine a big bag of your favourite candy/bonbons. How many different flavours do you have in your bag? Can you name some of them? In my imaginary bag of candy there are lemon, cherry, grape, watermelon, orange, and butterscotch to name just a few. I sometimes share my candy with other people. One thing I have noticed is that when I allow people to choose the flavour they want, some people are very picky about which flavour they choose. The favourite flavour seems to be blue raspberry. I don't think it is because they like the taste, I think it is because they like the way it turns their mouth blue! Whenever I let others choose, I always end up with all of the butterscotch left when all of the other flavours are gone. For some reason, people seldom choose the butterscotch suckers.

I don't know why people don't like butterscotch. I guess butterscotch is a little bit different. Maybe it isn't quite as sweet as grape or cherry, or some of the other flavours, or maybe they just don't like the colour of the paper wrapper.
