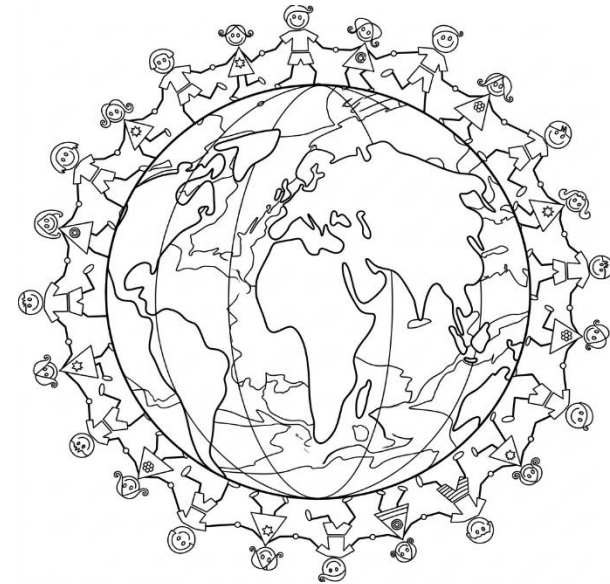

Everyone Is Welcome (Matthew 9:9–13)

One day, Jesus met a man called Matthew. Matthew was a tax collector. Many people did not like him because they thought he was dishonest and had made bad choices.

But Jesus saw Matthew differently.

Jesus simply said, "**Follow me.**"

Matthew got up and followed Jesus.
