☆ God Is Generous (Matthew 20.1-16)

Have you ever looked at what someone else has and thought:

"That's not fair! I want that too!"

It is easy to compare ourselves with other people.

In today's Bible story, Jesus told a story about workers in a vineyard.

Some workers started work early in the morning. Others came later.

At the end of the day, the owner gave **all the workers the same amount of money**.

The workers who had started early were not happy. They thought they should get more.

But the owner reminded them that he had given them exactly what he had promised.

Jesus used this story to teach us about God.

God is generous.

He doesn't love one person more than another.

He doesn't give his love only to people who have been good or who have been

Christians for a long time.

God's love is a gift for everyone.

So we don't need to compare ourselves with others.

Instead, we can be thankful for what God gives us and happy when he is generous to others.

The good news is simple: God loves us all, and his love is a gift.
